TAKING ON ADELAIDE'S ICON?

Welcome to RoofClimb Adelaide Oval, a two-hour scenic adventure across Adelaide Oval's unique roofline led by an expert RoofClimb Leader.

GETTING KITTED

Your dedicated RoofClimb Leader is with you for your entire RoofClimb journey from start to finish, kicking off with the safety briefing. Taking approximately 30 minutes, the briefing or kitting process will prepare you to Take on the Icon safely. During the kitting process, you will be issued and assisted with the fitting of your RoofClimb suit, safety harness and attachment trolley.

Personal secure lockers are available to store belongings and change rooms are located within the RoofClimb Centre preparation and debrief areas.

All participants will receive a RoofClimb Cap and over-ear audio system to hear commentary from your RoofClimb Leader throughout the journey.

We recommend wearing sunglasses during Day Climbs to avoid the glare from our incredibly white rooftop under the bright Adelaide sunshine!

THE CLIMB

- 1.5km (1,500 metres) in distance from start to finish along an industrial style walkway including open metal grate, stepped bridge and ladders
- Average of 2,289 steps taken throughout the journey
- Up to 50metres high at the lean-out point on the viewing platform
- Single, central handrail on the right-hand side throughout
- Climbers are required to travel unaided at a moderate walking pace wearing safety equipment weighing up to 4kg
- Total experience is approximately two hours including 80 minutes on climb
- Climbers wear a full body harness and are connected to a secure continuous saferail system with two points of connection
- Climbs continue in all weather conditions including rain, sun, moderate wind and moderate heat
- Maximum group size is 14 people with a dedicated RoofClimb Leader

THE CLIMBER

- Minimum age is 8 years at the time of experience.
- Maximum weight is 136kg/300lbs
- Minimum height is 120cm
- All Climbers will be breathalysed at time of check-in. Climbers returning a blood-alcohol concentration of 0.05% or above will be refused participation and forfeit their ticket.
- Loose items are not permitted on the climb due to strict safety protocol to avoid injury to patrons below. This includes watches, jewellery, cameras, tablet devices, phones and GoPros.

- All RoofClimb Leaders are professionally trained in photography and are equipped with tethered cameras which have passed through RoofClimb's rigorous safety testing. A photo is included as part of your RoofClimb experience with additional photos available to purchase after the experience.

HEALTH CONDITIONS

- Climbers 75 years and over must complete a RoofClimb Medical Clearance form, signed by a qualified medical practitioner no earlier than 21 days prior to their scheduled RoofClimb departure.
- Climbers less than 20 weeks pregnant are permitted to climb if they have had the RoofClimb Medical Clearance form signed by their medical practitioner. Climbers who are 20 or more weeks pregnant are not permitted to participate.
- Climbers with medical conditions may be required to provide a completed RoofClimb Medical Clearance form prior to their departure. Some medical conditions may prohibit participation.

WHAT TO WEAR

- Climbers must wear rubber-soled closed toe shoes (ie. runners or hiking boots)
- Climbers should wear weather appropriate clothing to go under their RoofClimb suits. During summer, less is best with changerooms available before and after your Climb. Winter can get a little chilly on roof so warm jackets and long pants are always a winner.
- A RoofClimb suit and safety equipment will be provided at the time of briefing
- Prescription glasses and sunglasses are permitted onto the Climb and a safety tether will be provided during briefing



TAKING ON THE ICON

RoofClimb is a two-hour experience including the safety briefing. The journey across the unique roofline of Adelaide Oval will take approximately 80 minutes, starting at the Western Stand entry point inside the ground. The journey is at a moderate walking pace taking in the spectacular views and stopping at key points for happy snaps along the way.

The only seating available during the experience is on the Riverbank Stand viewing platform, where the lean out point is located. Water is available at the entry and exit points of the structure.

WEATHER

We operate all year round in sunshine and rain with amazing experiences to be had in most conditions. RoofClimb will not proceed in high winds, thunderstorms, hail or extreme heat and our RoofClimb Team will contact all booked patrons ahead of any inclement weather advising of potential cancellation or rescheduling. RoofClimb has a direct relationship with the Bureau of Meteorology and monitors conditions daily to ensure suitability to climb.
